Dearly beloved,

The Holy Church, the body of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, was founded in India by St. Thomas, the Apostle. Let us praise God for the Church which prospers by the grace of God in the midst of innumerable crises. The Catholicate of the East is the epitome of the apostolic heritage, identity and indigenous character of Malankara Sabha. The Church Day or Catholicate Day is set apart for recollecting the value and relevance of Catholicate and for offering special prayers for the Church. The Catholicate Day 2021 falls on 21st March, the 36th Day (Sunday) of the Great Lent. Although the observance of Catholicate Day this year is to be arranged on the back drop of Covid -19 pandemic and the restrictions associated with it; our parishes shall take all steps to celebrate the day in the most appropriate and befitting manner. It is our fervent wish that the Catholicate Day observance shall be an opportunity for us to grow into the fullness of the Holy Spirit, through personal transformation, sanctification of our sacramental life and renewal of our families. Special prayers shall be offered for the Holy Church during Holy Qurbana on the day. The Catholicate Flag shall be hoisted and all our faithful shall take the Catholicate Day oath. Speeches shall be delivered to enlighten our people on the relevance of the Catholicate, the faith, tradition and heritage of the Church.

The main source of income of the Church is the amount collected through the Catholicate Day Cover Collection. We primarily depend on this collection for funding various welfare charitable activities of the Church and the nurturing of our spiritual organisations.

The Church faces great difficulty in funding various projects of the Church due to the inadequacy of funds raised through the Catholicate Day last year in the midst of Covid crisis. We are indeed very happy to state here that, in spite of the Covid pandemic and the consequent crisis, the Church could help thousands of deserving families which faced acute financial problems by depositing Rupees One Thousand each in their respective bank accounts.

Dearly beloved,

The Church has decided to raise a minimum of Rupees Ten Crores in 2021 – 22 through the Catholicate day cover collection. All our faithful shall sincerely take part in the observance of Catholicate Day, every faithful shall donate the average income of a day for the various developmental projects of the Church. We lovingly exhort you to participate in this venture, inspired by the love and devotion of the Church. We remind you of the scriptural instruction 'tithes belong to God'.

The Catholicate Day cover and the folder should reach every family at the right time. Make a special drive to collect donations from well wishers, traders and beaurocrats. The vicars of parishes shall take an initiative in this matter.


Visit maximum members of houses adhering to Covid restrictions and collect an amount exceeding the target amount. The amount so collected shall be submitted at the Catholicate Office along with the offertory on Catholicate Day and Resessa at the stipulated time. We could raise only Rupees Three Crores in place of the target amount of Ten Crores on account of the Covid consequences last year. The minimum amount to be collected from one Outside Kerala family is ₹ 400. For others, one day's average income is targeted. On the basis of this, a family of that parish shall donate ₹ 400/- and the total target for the parish is ₹.....
