It is known to everybody that our Church has been established in India by St. Thomas. By the incalculable grace of God, the Church is thriving in the midst of many crises and challenges. Let us praise God for that. The Catholicate of the East is the symbol of the apostolic heritage, identity and indigenous character. Sabha Dinam or Catholicate Day is set apart to recollect the relevance and value of Catholicate and to pray for the Church. The Catholicate Day 2022 falls on 3rd April, the 36th Sunday of Great lent. In spite of the fact that this year too the Catholicate Day is observed on the backdrop of Covid -19 pandemic and the consequent restrictions, our faithful in the Church shall strive to observe the day in the most befitting manner.
