Blessings to our beloved Vicar of.....church, priests of the locality, Kaisthanees of the church, and all members of the parish!

Dearly Beloved,

Let us glorify God for the growth of our Church, established by the Holy Apostle St. Thomas, amidst challenges. The Catholicate of the East, a symbol of the Malankara Church's self-awareness, deeply reflects the Apostolic heritage, indigenous identity, and freedom of the Holy Church. The observance of the Catholicate Day must be arranged to enhance the spiritual vitality of the Holy Church and to pray specifically for the Church. The Catholicate Day in 2025 falls on the 6th of April, which is the 36th Sunday of the Great Lent. The celebration of Catholicate Day should become an opportunity to grow towards the fullness of the Holy Spirit. On that day, we must pray specifically for the Holy Church during the Holy *Qurbana*; hoist the Catholicate flag and the whole congregation shall take the pledge of the Catholicate Day. In connection with the celebrations, special instructions should be given related to the relevance of the Catholicate and the faith and traditions of the Holy Church. In places where there is no Holy *Qurbana* on that particular day, celebrations should be conducted the following Sunday, and special offerings should be collected.

The funds raised through the Catholicate Day collection are indeed the main source of income for the Holy Church. We primarily rely on the Catholicate Day collection for the charitable activities of the Holy Church and the sustenance of spiritual organizations. Since the amount raised through the Catholicate Day collection last year was less than expected, it has become impossible to provide full financial support for the church's various projects.

Dear ones,

As part of the goal to start 'Public Relation Centers' in all major cities in Kerala, ground has been broken to build a center in Thiruvananthapuram, and activities have begun in a rented building in Ernakulam. Land has been acquired in Kodungallur, where Apostle St. Thomas first imprinted his footprints in India, and a foundation stone has been laid for a suitable memorial. We desire to establish a 'Public Health Institute' on approximately 5 acres of land received as a donation at Haripad near the National Highway. Arrangements will be made for teaching paramedical courses under the supervision of the Perumala Hospital, on the property owned by the Church in Kozhuvallur. A camp center in Mathilakam and the expansion of the Ayurvedic hospital that has started functioning in Kottayam, Panachikkad are also part of our dreams. Construction of 'Welfare Homes' for senior citizens has already begun on 9.5 acres of land in Paingottur near Muvattupuzha. The 'Ardra Charitable Project' and the 'Sahodaran' project continue to strengthen the Church's charitable activities that can never be forgotten. We primarily rely on the Catholicate Day

collection for the realization of all these projects. Advancing the works of the Holy Church, which is the body of our Lord, is indeed part of the Church's mission. It has been decided to collect a total of 22 crores rupees through the Catholicate Day collection for the year 2025-26, including 15 crores from parishes, 5 crores from individuals, and 2 crores from the institutions of the church. Each family should contribute at least one day's average income to the progress of the Holy Church. The average income should be calculated as the total daily earnings of all individuals with a regular income in the family. We lovingly request everyone to view this matter as an offering to God, as a symbol of love and care towards the Church's progress. We must remember the biblical truth that 'The tithe belongs to God.' All church members should sincerely cooperate in the observance of Church Day and the collection of offerings.

To reach the collection target, the Catholicate Day envelopes and folders must be distributed to all households promptly. Parish priests should take a special interest in this matter, visiting as many homes as possible to collect an amount that exceeds the target. This amount, along with the Catholicate Day offertory and *reeshisa*, should be paid at the church center within the stipulated time. We praise God for moving closer to the target of 10 crore rupees set for last year. Accordingly, the contribution amount for each household of that parish has been fixed at a minimum of rupees. The target for that parish will be rupees. The envelopes and folders will be delivered from the Church center to all Diocesan centers. The responsibility of distributing the envelopes and folders to parishes will be taken by the Diocese, and the parish officials must ensure they reach every household before April 6, the Catholicate Day.

Please remember to pray for Us the humble and meek, Our brother bishops, the clergy, the religious communities, spiritual organization workers, and believers around the world. The prayer of each believer is valuable for establishing eternal peace in the Church and eradicating divisions and conflicts completely.

May the Grace and Blessings of the God Almighty abide with you forever. And may the prayers of the Mother of our God, the Holy Virgin Mary, St. Thomas the Apostle of India, our Holy Fathers Yeldo Mar Baselios, Mar Gregorios, Mar Dionysius and all the Holy Saints be a stronghold for us. Amen.
